An in-house review of the Metropolitan Water Reclamation District of Greater Chicago's (District) Sewage and Waste Control Ordinance (SWCO) by the Monitoring and Research Department established the need to amend certain provisions of the SWCO.

The amendments are summarized as follows:

 Appendix F, Section I of the SWCO is amended to provide new Noncompliance Enforcement (NCE) Charge rates applicable for 2011. The 2011 billing rates for Notices of Noncompliance, Cease & Desist (C&D) Orders and Show Cause for Legal Actions are as follows:
