Request Authority to Amend the User Charge Ordinance of the Metropolitan Water Reclamation District of Greater Chicago

Dear Sir:

An in-house review of the Metropolitan Water Reclamation District of Greater Chicago's User Charge Ordinance (Ordinance) by the Monitoring and Research Department established the need to amend the Ordinance to provide modification of certain provisions of the Ordinance.

The amendments are summarized as follows:

1. Appendix F, Section I is amended to modify the User Charge rates applicable to Large Commercial-Industrial and Tax-Exempt User classes. The 2018 billing rates for flow, biochemical oxygen demand (BOD) and suspended solids (SS) are as follows:

2. Appendix F, Section III is amended to modify the Operations, Maintenance and Replacement (OM&R) Factor as follows:

The recommended rates were agreed upon by the User Charge Blue Ribbon Panel in 2013. Attached is "An Ordinance to Amend the User Charge Ordinance of the Metropolitan Water Reclamation District of Greater Chicago, As Amended." We recommend adoption of the proposed Ordinance amendments. These Ordinance amendments will take effect on January 1, 2018.
