Request Authority to Amend the User Charge Ordinance of the Metropolitan Water Reclamation District of Greater Chicago

..Body

Dear Sir:

An in-house review of the Metropolitan Water Reclamation District of Greater Chicago's User Charge Ordinance (Ordinance) by the Monitoring and Research Department established the need to amend the Ordinance to provide modification of certain provisions of the Ordinance.

The amendments are summarized as follows:

1. Grammatical edits to correct spelling errors in Sections 4.I, 8.b, 9, 9.f, Appendix A, Section III, Appendix B, Section I, and Section VII, Appendix C, Section I, and Appendix E, Section I.
2. Appendix F, Section I is amended to modify the User Charge rates applicable to Large Commercial-Industrial and Tax-Exempt User classes. The 2019 billing rates for flow, biochemical oxygen demand (BOD) and suspended solids (SS) are as follows:


LARGE COMMERCIAL-INDUSTRIAL AND TAX EXEMPT USER RATES:


	2018 Rates	Recommended 2019 Rates
(1) Volume	\$264.28 per million gallons	\$269.04 per million gallons
(2) 5-day BOD	\$223.03 per thousand pounds of BOD	\$216.64 per thousand pounds of BOD
(3) SS	\$136.48 per thousand pounds of SS	\$130.38 per thousand pounds of SS

3. Appendix F, Section III is amended to modify the Operations, Maintenance and Replacement (OM&R) Factor as follows:

2018 OM&R Factor	Recommended 2019 OM&R Factor
0.301	0.328

The recommended rates were agreed upon by the User Charge Blue Ribbon Panel in 2013. Attached is "An Ordinance to Amend the User Charge Ordinance of the Metropolitan Water Reclamation District of Greater Chicago, As Amended." We recommend adoption of the proposed Ordinance amendments. These Ordinance amendments will take effect on January 1, 2019.
