 - · Green analysis elimination of mercury reagent





TOC is allowed for permit compliance as long as a correlation to BOD has been established (Clean Water Act 40 CFR part 133.104)


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
- Upgraded monitoring systems for efficiency

 - Installed new Hydrogen Sulfide sensors that can detect concentration at level of parts per billion with telemetry features



- The Diversity staff currently includes: 4 CCA's, 1 MCA, and 2 ECMCA's


