On December 29, 2008, the Board of Commissioners authorized the Director of Procurement and Materials Management to issue a purchase order and enter into an agreement with Dykema Gossett, PLLC in an amount not to exceed \$87,978.56.

This contract has no prior change orders.

This decrease in purchase order value is being requested due to the conclusion of the lawsuit.

This change order is in compliance with the Illinois Criminal Code since the change is due to circumstances not reasonably foreseeable at the time the contract was signed, and is in the best interest of the District.

It is hereby recommended that the Board of Commissioners authorize the Director of Procurement and Materials Management to execute a change order to decrease purchase order and amend the agreement, in an amount of \$30,388.57 (34.8% of the current contract value), from an amount of \$87,987.56 to an amount not to exceed \$57,589.99.
