The purpose of this contract is to furnish and deliver janitorial supplies, such as brooms, mops, buckets, etc., to the District's storerooms, to maintain sufficient inventory levels, that are required for the day-to-day operational needs of the District.

The estimated cost for this contract is \$144,000.00.

No bid deposit is required for this contract.

The Multi-Project Labor Agreement (MPLA) is not applicable to this contract because it is primarily a furnish and deliver contract.
