Contract documents and specifications have been prepared to Furnish and Deliver Unleaded Gasoline to Various Locations for a One (1) Year Period, beginning approximately January 1, 2011 and ending December 31, 2011.

The purpose of this contract is to furnish and deliver unleaded gasoline to the District's storeroom and other gasoline storage locations, to maintain sufficient inventory levels, that are required for the day to day maintenance needs of the District.

The estimated cost for this contract is \$359,000.00.

The bid deposits for this contract are \$13,400.00 for Item A, and \$3,300.00 for Item B.

The Multi-Project Labor Agreement (MPLA) is not applicable to this contract because it is primarily a furnish and deliver contract.

Revised Appendix D is not included in this contract because it is primarily a furnish and deliver contract.

The tentative schedule for this contract is as follows:

Bid Opening November 16, 2010
Award December 2, 2010
Completion December 31, 2011

Funds are being requested in 2011, in Accounts 101-20000, 66000-623820, and are contingent on the Board of Commissioners' approval of the District's budget for that year.
