Dear Mr. St. Pierre:

As a follow up to meeting with you and your staff in which we discussed the aforementioned project, on behalf of the City of Northlake I am respectfully requested the preparation of a "draft" Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) between the City of Northlake (City) and Metropolitan Water Reclamation District (MWRD) for the capital improvement project to restore the section of Addison Creek from Palmer Avenue to Wolf Road. Per the date of this letter, the City has secured the \$2M in funding to move the project forward. The Addison Creek River Conservancy District (ACRCD) which is a governmental agency that is responsible for maintaining Addison Creek thru the City of Northlake approved at their meeting on September 5, 2012 to allocate up to \$1M in funding to assist with the construction of the restoration project (see attached Agenda and Minutes). The City has allocated \$1M in funding as well. On behalf of the City I am respectfully requesting \$1M from MWRD to make this project a reality. This project will benefit not only the City of Northlake but the Lower Des Plaines Water Shed. I have also attached the Minutes of Meeting and Color Exhibit from our meeting in August 2012.
