

## North Branch of Chicago River Restoration Between Montrose Ave. and Berteau Ave., NSA

**Project Description:** The purpose of the project is to restore approximately 1,330 feet of the East bank of the North Branch of the Chicago River, between Montrose Avenue and Berteau Avenue, in the City of Chicago. The scope of project work includes installing a new sheet pile wall along the river bank, installing riprap and articulated concrete block mats for erosion control and slope stabilization, and some landscaping.

**Project Justification:** The river bank slope has deteriorated over the years due to hydraulic erosion, slope failures, and sloughing of the original river channel bank, thus potentially compromising the slopes and impacting residential structures that are in the vicinity.

**Project Status:** Project has completed 98 percent review and is awaiting a tri-party permit from the United States Army Corps of Engineers before advertisement.
