Our review of this grant agreement indicates that affirmative action goals are not recommended.

The District is requesting to enter into a Tailored Research Collaboration (TRC) agreement with the Water Research Foundation for a study on balancing carbon management, energy management, energy production, nutrient removal, and densification. As part of the terms of the TRC, the District's monetary contribution will be \$150,000.00.

This agreement is not suitable for affirmative action participation goals therefore, the Appendix A and the Appendix V should not be included. However, Wastewater Microbial Solutions, a minority and women owned business, will be participating on this project. Their estimated participation amount is \$40,000.00 which is twenty-seven percent (27%) of the District's monetary contribution.
