On August 6, 2015, the report on advertisement for the request for proposal 15-EOI-02, Expression of Interest, Liquid Organic Waste Supply Delivery to the Stickney and Calumet Water Reclamation Plants, was sent to the Board of Commissioners.

On September 2, 2015, the request for proposal was advertised and responses were received on September 25, 2015.

The purpose of this Request for Expressions of Interest is to quantify the liquid organic waste material that is available in the region and identify the potential suppliers who would find it advantageous to dispose of the liquid organic waste in the District's anaerobic digesters at the Stickney and Calumet Water Reclamation Plants. The information submitted by the proposers was used to prepare a subsequent Request for Proposal (15-RFP-27) to solicit proposals for an organic waste supply chain manager. Therefore, all responses are being rejected in the public's best interest. The Director of Procurement and Materials Management has notified all firms of this action.
