Contract documents and specifications have been prepared for Contract 22-986-11 Locomotive Repair Services at the Stickney Water Reclamation Plant, at the request of the Maintenance and Operations Department.

The purpose of this contract is to procure the services of a certified locomotive repair technician to provide support and locomotive parts for the maintenance of four locomotives, including re-railing services.

The estimated cost of this contract is not to exceed \$315,000.00. The estimated 2022, 2023 and 2024 expenditures are \$105,000.00, \$105,000.00 and \$105,000.00 respectively.

The Multi-Project Labor Agreement (MPLA) and Affirmative Action Ordinance, Revised Appendix D and Appendix V will not be included in this contract due to the specialized nature of the services.

Completion December 31, 2024
