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### **TRANSMITTAL LETTER FOR BOARD MEETING OF FEBRUARY 18, 2021**

Authority to increase purchase order with AT&T Corporation, for Contract 18-RFP-16 POTs Local and Long Distance Services, in an amount of \$53,923.14, from an amount of \$437,600.22, to an amount not to exceed \$491,523.36, Account 101-27000-612210, Purchase Order 3103834

Dear Sir:

On December 6, 2018, the Board of Commissioners authorized the Director of Procurement and Materials Management to issue purchase order and enter into an agreement for Contract 18-RFP-16, POTs Local and Long Distance Services with AT&T Corporation, in an amount not to exceed \$630,000.00, amended at the February 21, 2019 meeting to \$210,000.00, with two one year options at the same value.

As of January 21, 2021, the attached list of change orders has been approved. The effect of these change orders resulted in an increase in an amount of \$ 227,600.22 from the original amount awarded of \$210,000.00. The current contract value is \$437,600.22. The prior approved change orders reflect a 108% increase to the original contract value.

The change order is necessary to continue service through March 14, 2021 while a new contract is finalized.

This change order is in compliance with the Illinois Criminal Code since the change is due to circumstances not reasonably foreseeable at the time the contract was signed, and is in the best interest of the District.

It is hereby recommended that the Board of Commissioners authorize the Director of Procurement and Materials Management to execute a change order to increase the purchase order for Contract 18-RFP-16 in an amount of \$53,923.14 (12.3% of the current contract value), from an amount of \$437,600.22, to an amount not to exceed \$491,523.36.
