Contract documents and specifications have been prepared for Contract 23-824-11, Furnish and Deliver One Horizontal Wheel Press to the Calumet Water Reclamation Plant, at the request of the Maintenance and Operations Department.

The purpose of this contract is to furnish and deliver one horizontal wheel press to the Calumet Water Reclamation Plant. This press will be used to disassemble and assemble large pump rotating elements during overhauls.

The total estimated cost of the contract is \$286,000.00.

The Multi-Project Labor Agreement will not be included because this is a furnish and deliver contract.

The Affirmative Action Ordinance Revised Appendix D and Appendix V are not included in this contract because there are no subcontracting opportunities available because the requested work is not divisible.
