
2026 Budget Highlights

- Electricity savings due to Carbon Free Energy Resource Adjustment Credit
- Maintaining commitment to advance funding the Retirement Fund

2026 Budget Challenges

- Increasing healthcare and employee benefit costs
- Declining revenues and lingering inflationary pressures
- Balancing Capital Improvement financing with capital needs





Metropolitan Water Reclamation District of Greater Chicago Retirement Fund Discussion

Actuarial Projection Modeler shows a need to change the 4.19 multiplier to determine an adequate contribution to the Retirement Fund.



From 2020 - 2025, the District contributed \$152.8 million in advance funding to the Retirement Fund.



Metropolitan Water Reclamation District of Greater Chicago Other Post-Employment Benefits (OPEB) Trust Discussion

The OPEB Trust has had solid investment returns and asset growth, resulting in a funded ratio above 100%.

As of September 30, 2025:

- \$402.9 million in assets
- Returns are 12.0 percent year-to-date
- Actuarial Liability is \$340.1 million
